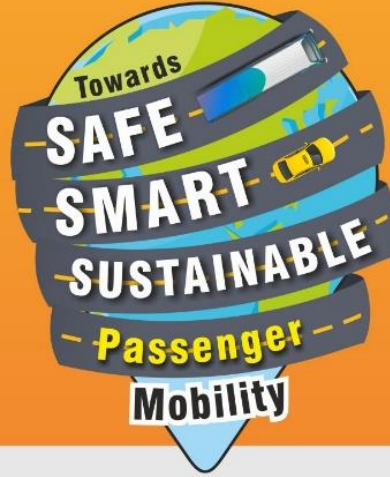

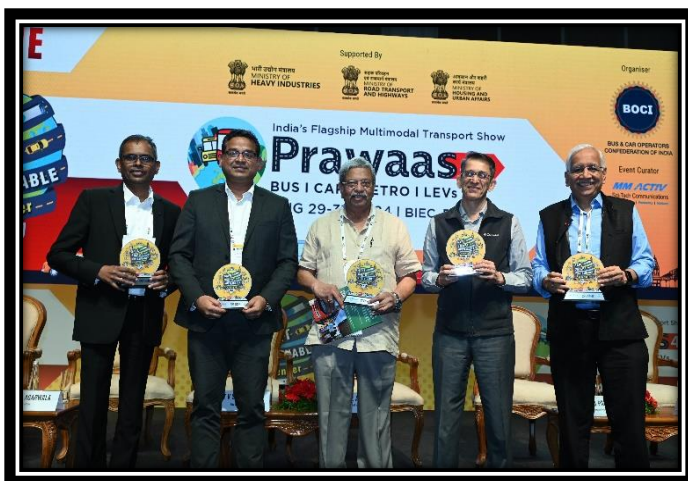

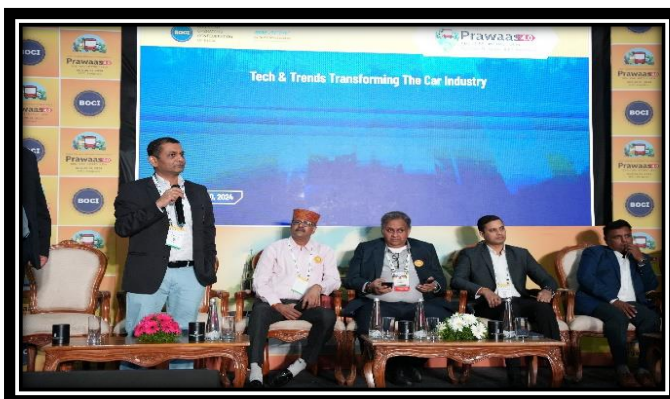

MAJOR HIGHLIGHTS OF PRAWAAS 4.0

Display from OEMs (Original Equipment Manufacturers)

Tata Motors Commercial Vehicles, India's largest commercial vehicle manufacturer, showcased an impressive array of cutting-edge mass and mobility solutions. TML unveiled the new Tata Ultra EV 7M, an intra-city electric bus designed for the urban mass transport. Also Tata Motors presented various passenger transport solutions, including the Tata Magna EV, Tata Magic Bi-fuel, Tata Ultra Prime CNG, Tata Winger 9S, Tata CityRide Prime, and Tata LPO 1822.

VECV, a joint venture between the Volvo Group and Eicher Motors displayed the next generation Volvo and Eicher buses at PRAWAAS 4.0. The company displayed the upgraded Volvo 9600 Coach, the electric Eicher Skyline Pro-E 13.5m Intercity Coach, and the Eicher Skyline Pro 3010 School Bus.

JBM displayed the groundbreaking technology with the Intercity Electric Bus 'Galaxy' 12.4m at Prawaas 4.0.

This interactive approach helped to create buzz within the local community, ultimately increasing footfall and participation at the event.

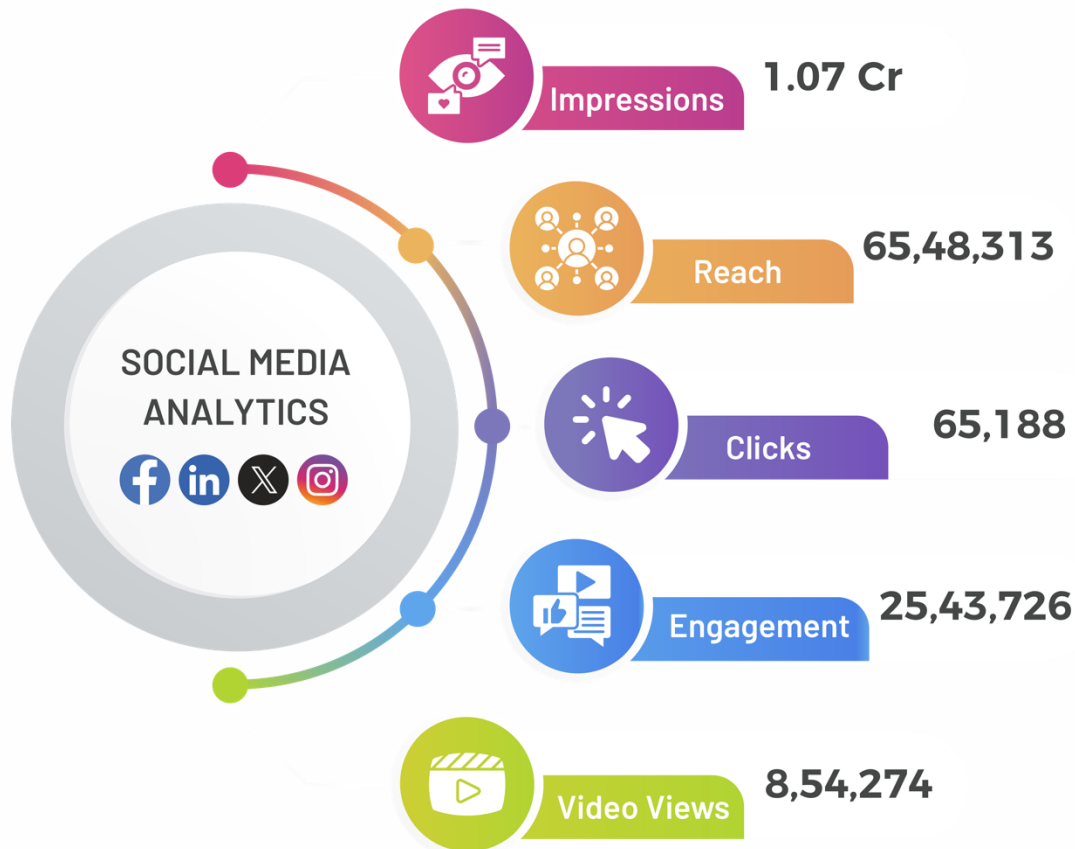
